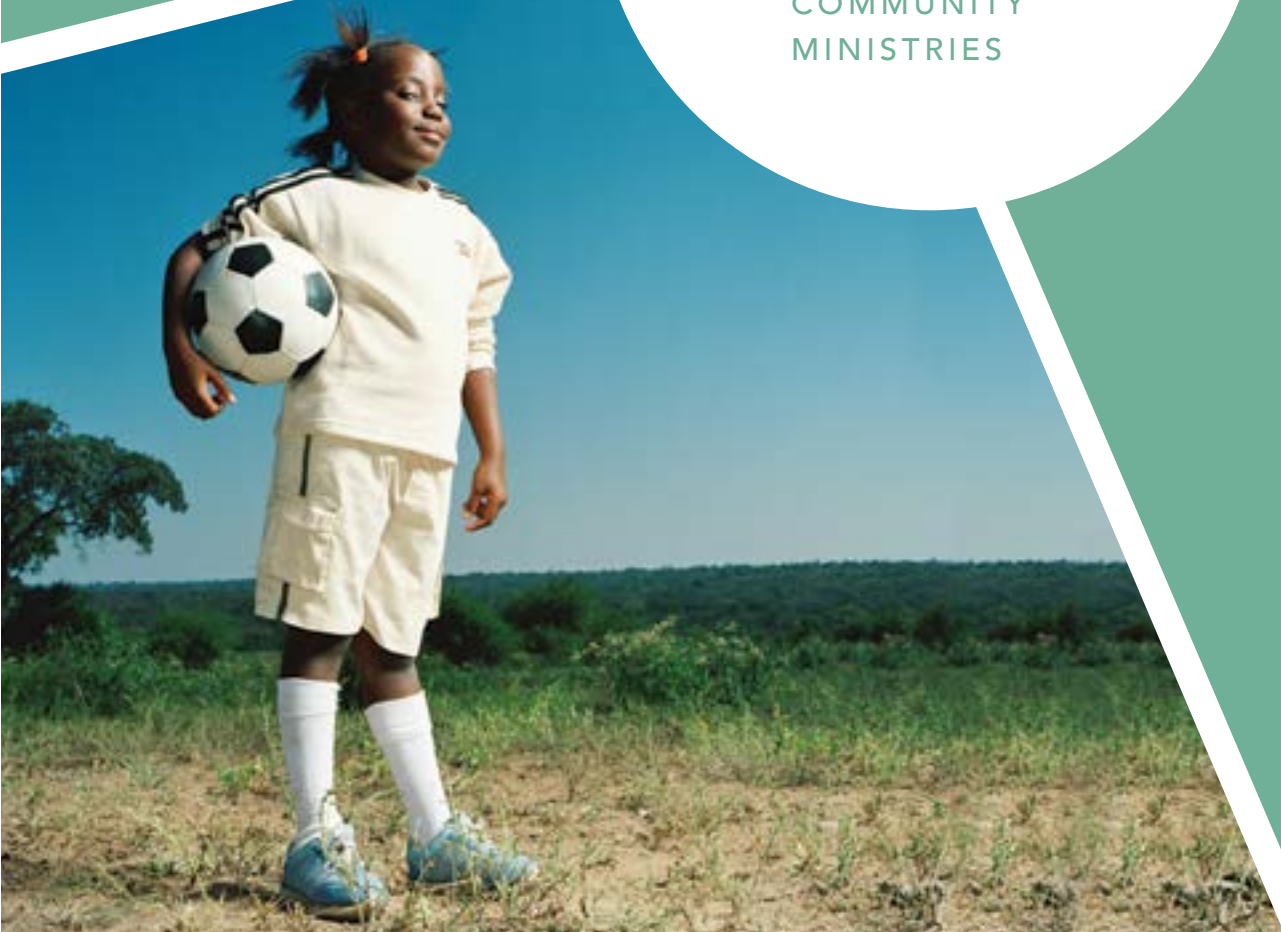

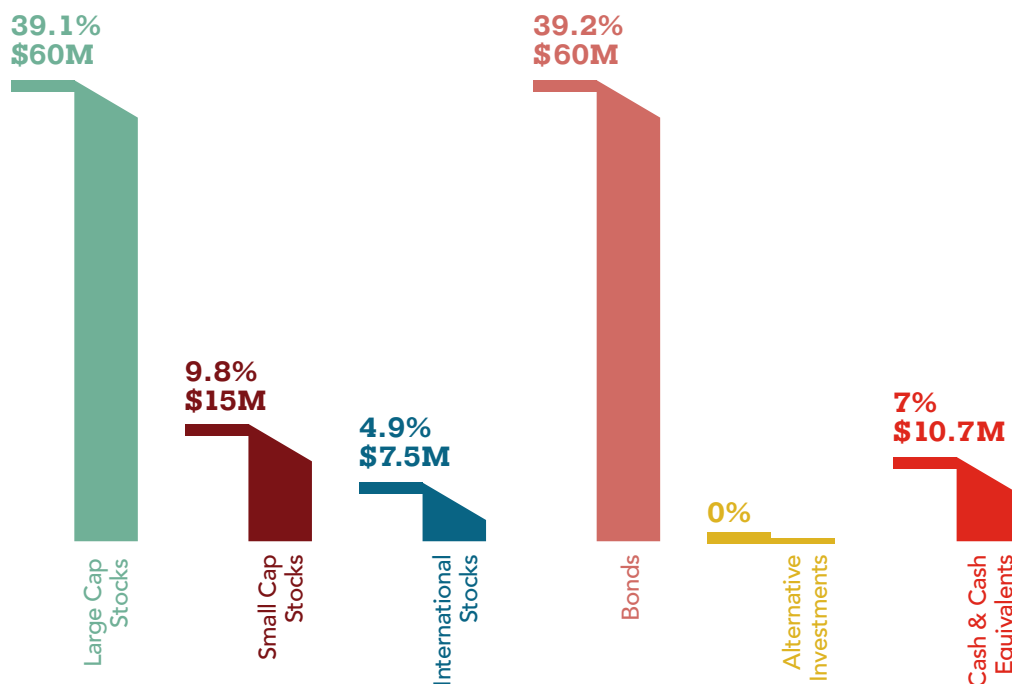

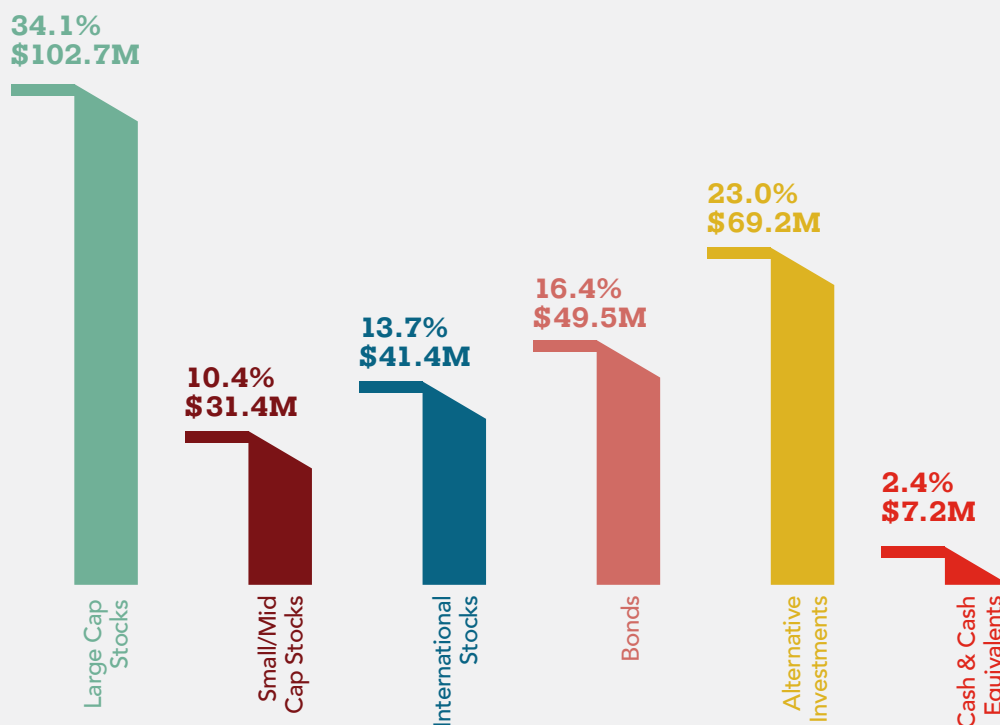
Investment Position.

Core Funding

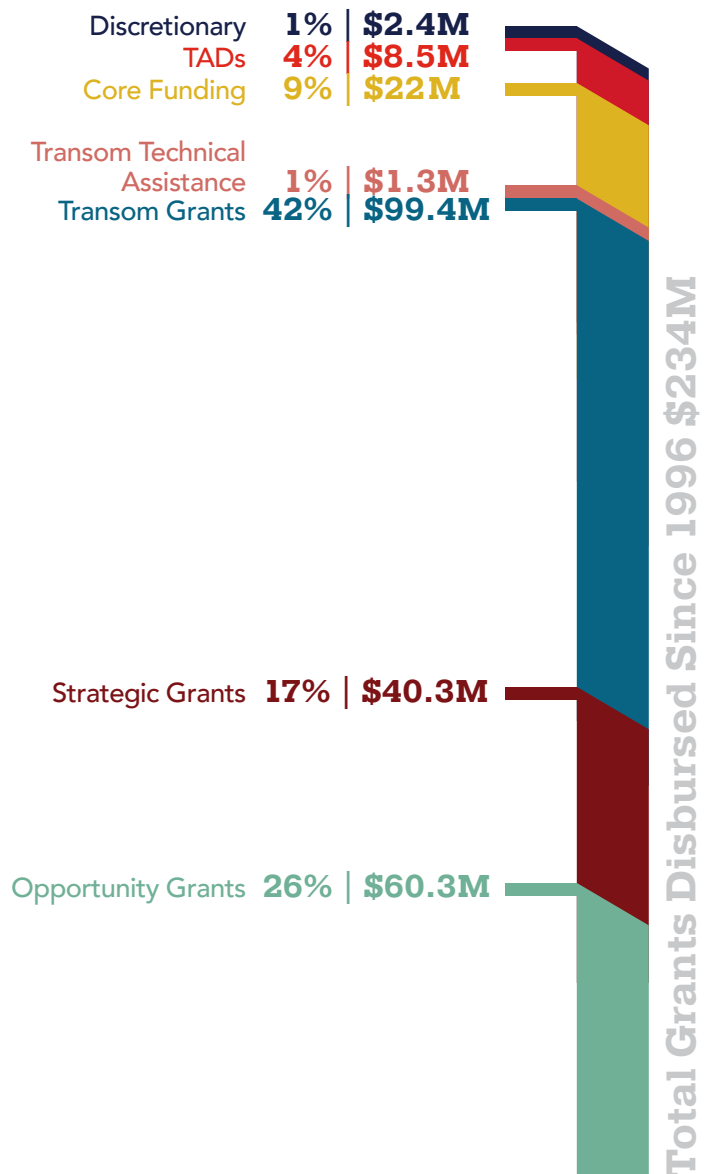
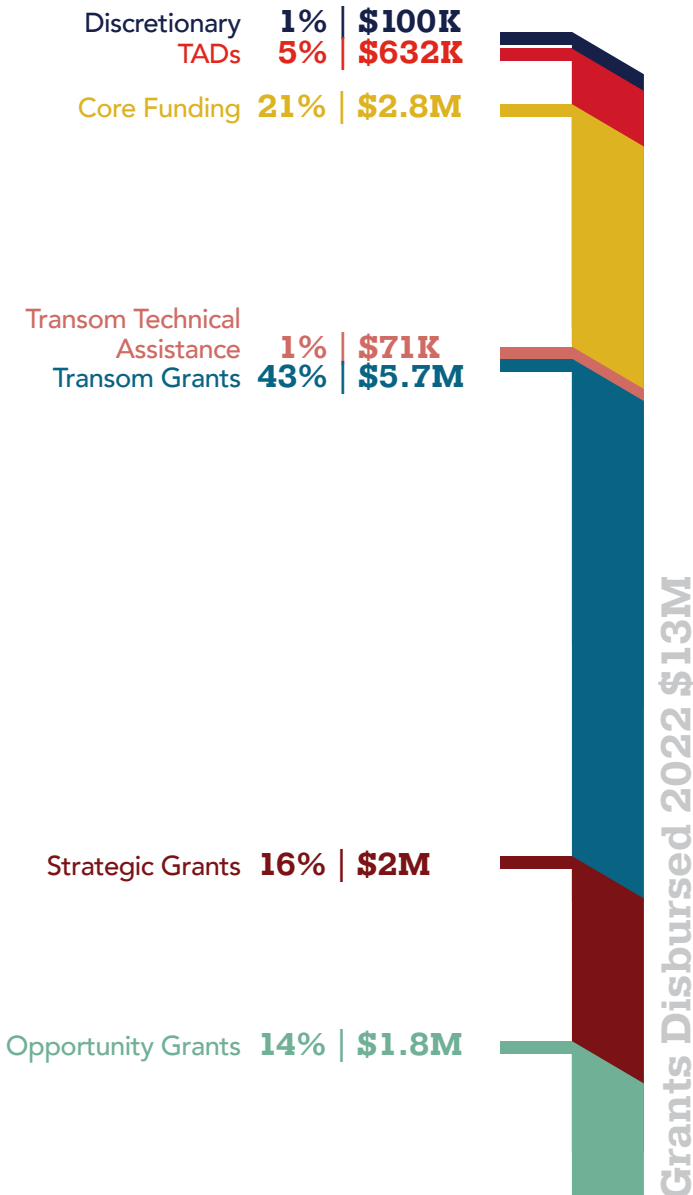
By invitation only; Provides general operating support for faith-based Christian organizations
